Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in October 2014 to consider an application from New Brunswick Power Corporation (NB Power) to amend the Point Lepreau Nuclear Generating Station (PLNGS) *Power Reactor Operating Licence* (PROL). The PLNGS is located on the Lepreau Peninsula, 40 km southwest of Saint John, New Brunswick.

During the 2012 PROL renewal, the Unsealed Source Maximum Quantities were reduced. NB Power is requesting that these quantities be updated in the current PROL to better reflect current unsealed source inventory as well as previous allowable quantities.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary for considering this request from NB Power. The requested changes are administrative in nature and do not raise matters related to health, safety or environmental protection that would warrant being considered in the context of a public hearing. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and NB Power.

Following the deliberations in a closed session and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC website and made available to the public.
