The Task Force on Foods from Biotechnology held a special briefing session for members of the Canadian General Standards Board on November 14th, 2001. Your participation and input in this session on consumer research was missed.

At this session, the Task Force shared the latest quantitative consumer research, conducted by Ipsos-Reid, to assist the food industry in determining the optimal methodology for conveying information regarding food biotechnology to the consumer.

This research indicated that there may be serious implications for members of the agri-food industry regarding labelling of genetically modified foods, and revealed that consumers have concerns regarding the safety of foods from biotechnology:

40% consumers view labels as warning* 25% consumers less likely to buy products labelled GM* 27% consumers would actively seek out non-GM alternatives* 51 % consumers see GM products unacceptable* 87% want all genetically modified foods labelled* 70% also want animal treatment and husbandry practices labelled
