5. The arts make vivid the fact that neither words in their literal form nor numbers exhaust what we can know. The limits of our language do not define the limits of our cognition.

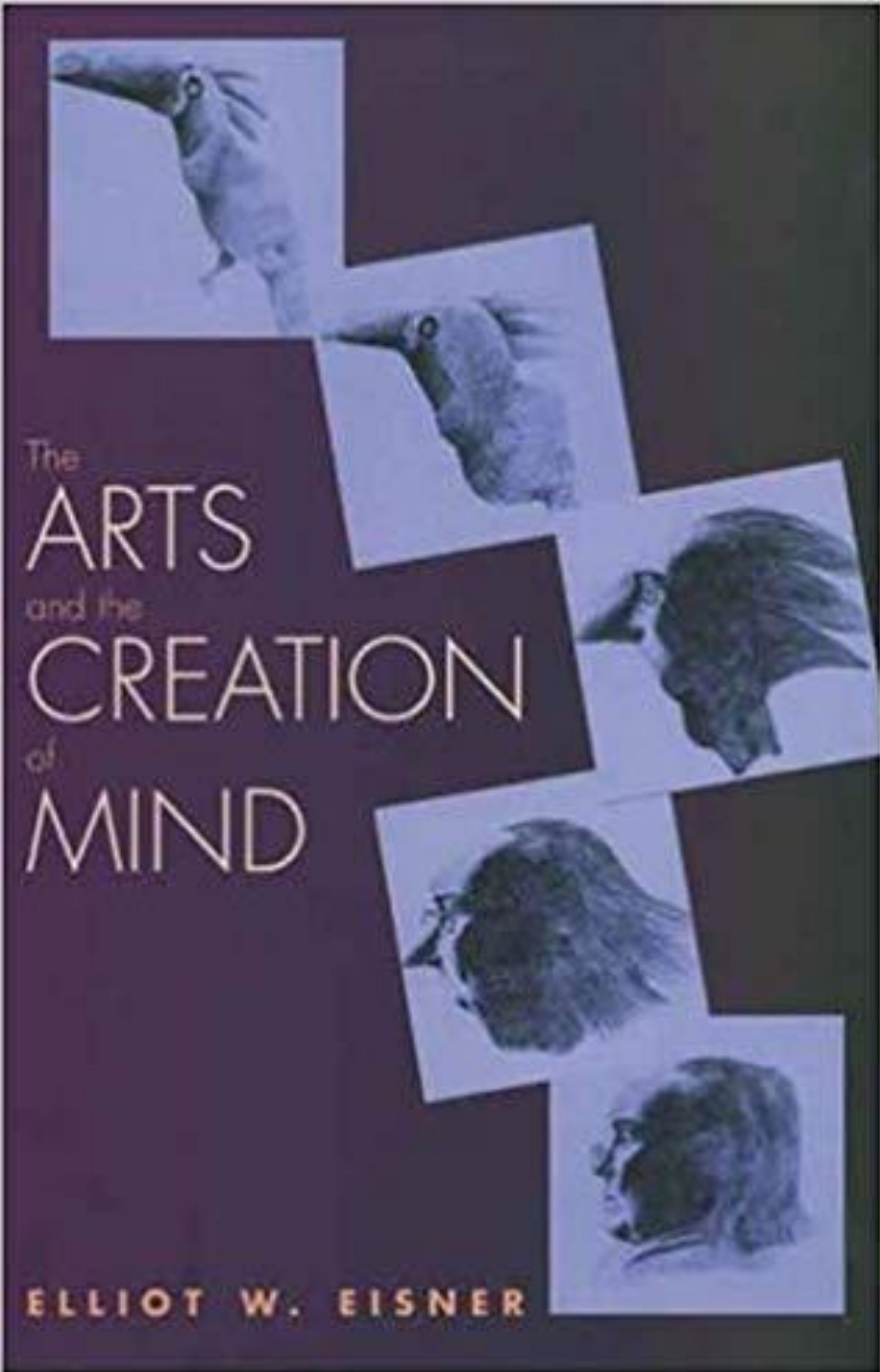

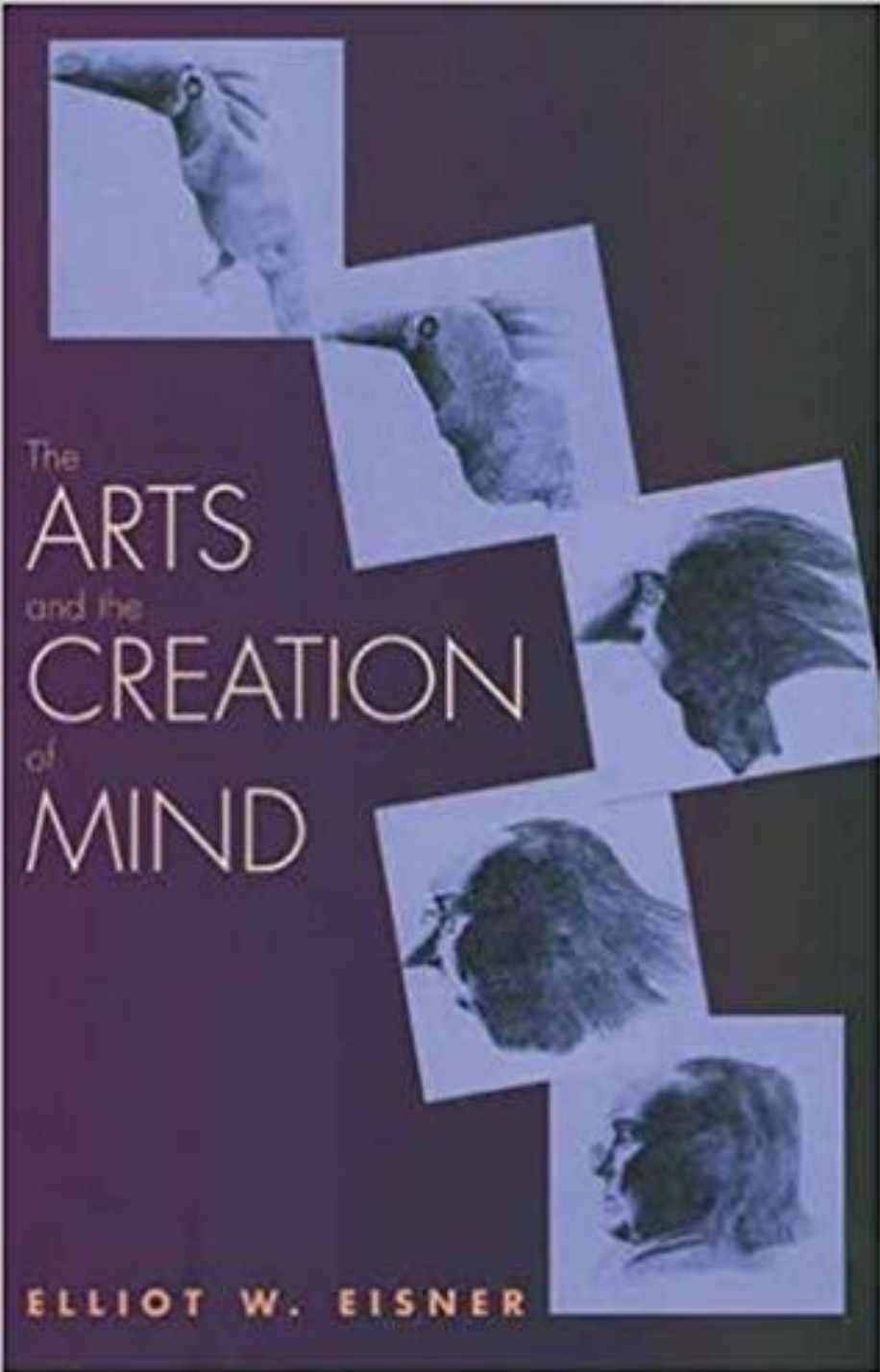






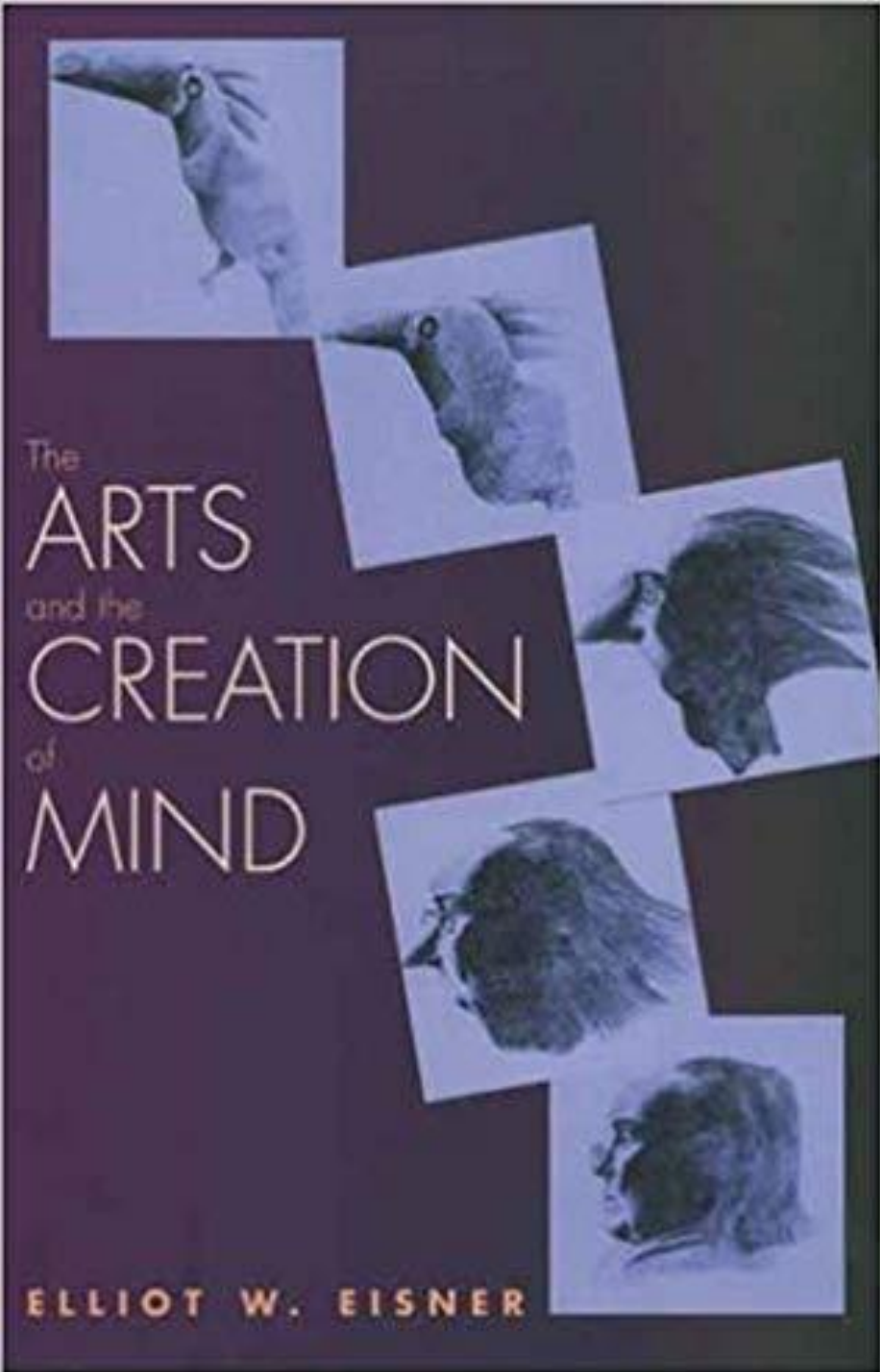
7. The arts teach us to think through and within a material. All art forms employ some means through which images become real.
