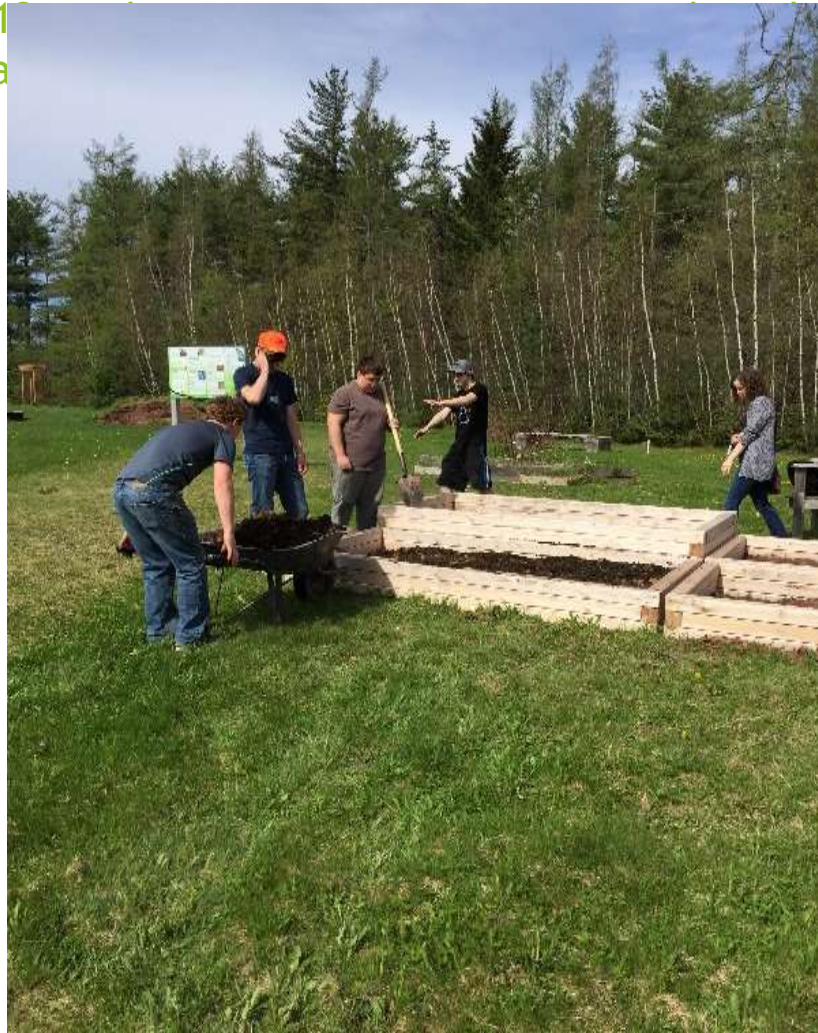
Eco Kids Club

Our middle level students work the ground for the beds, help plant and work with our compost. Elementary students help with planting.



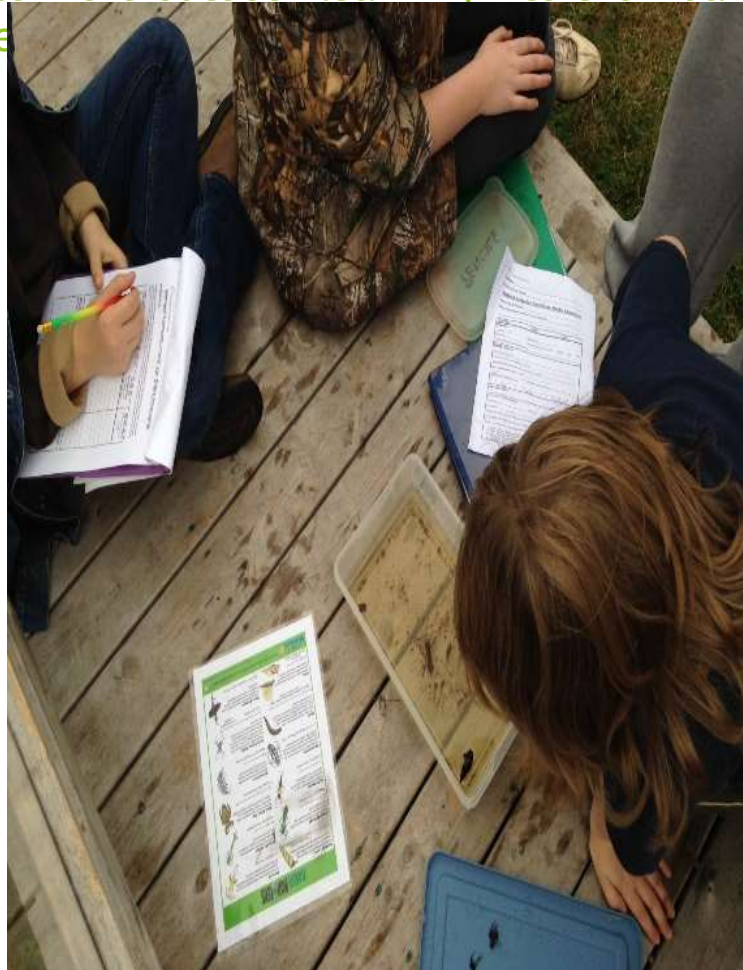
Gardening & Trails



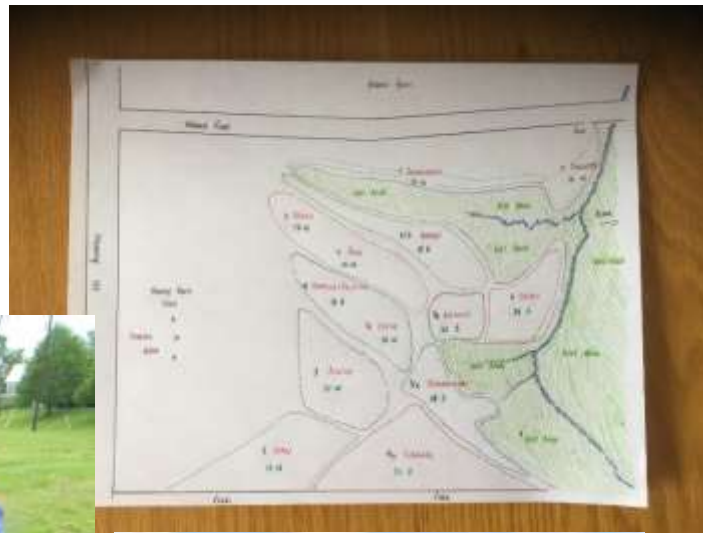
