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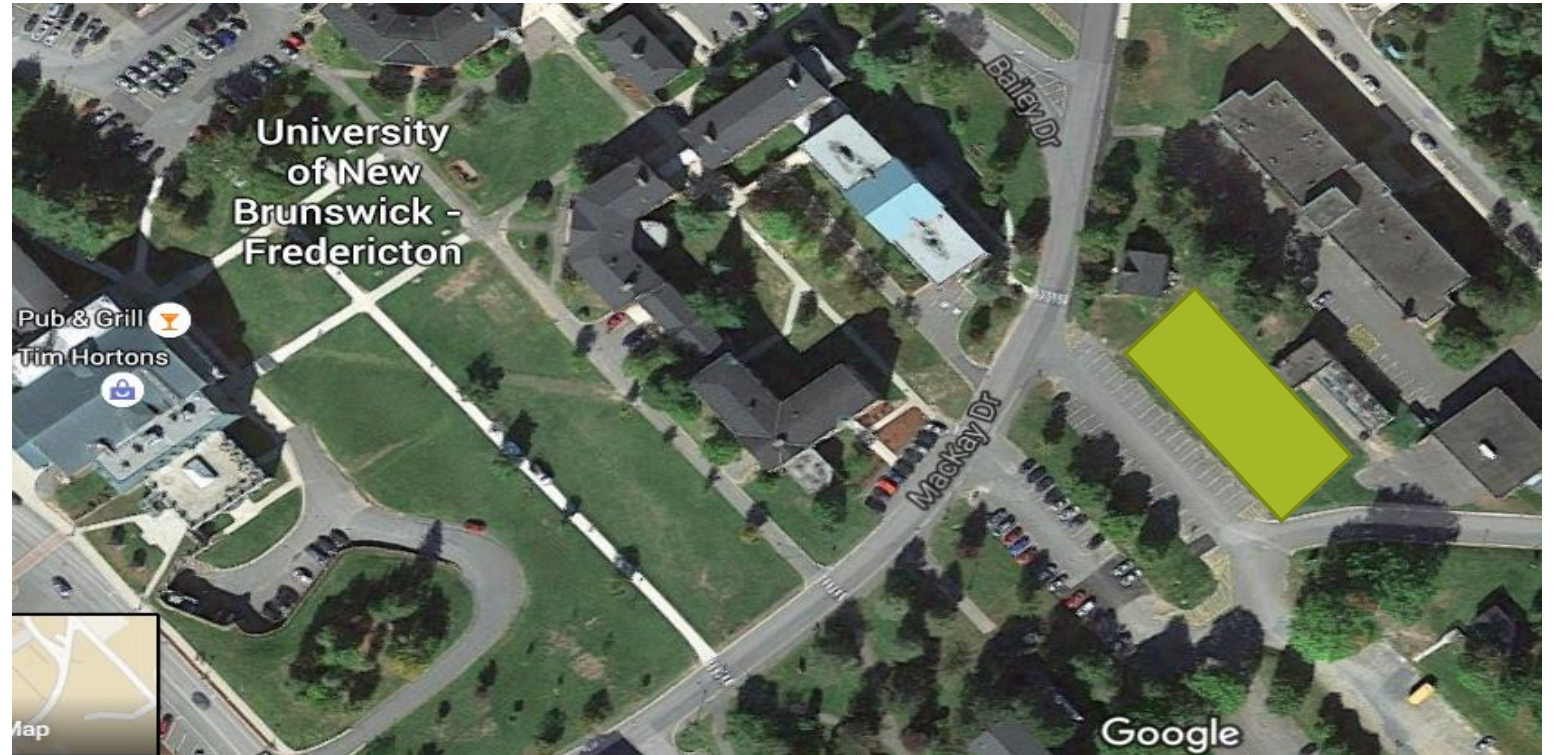


MISSION

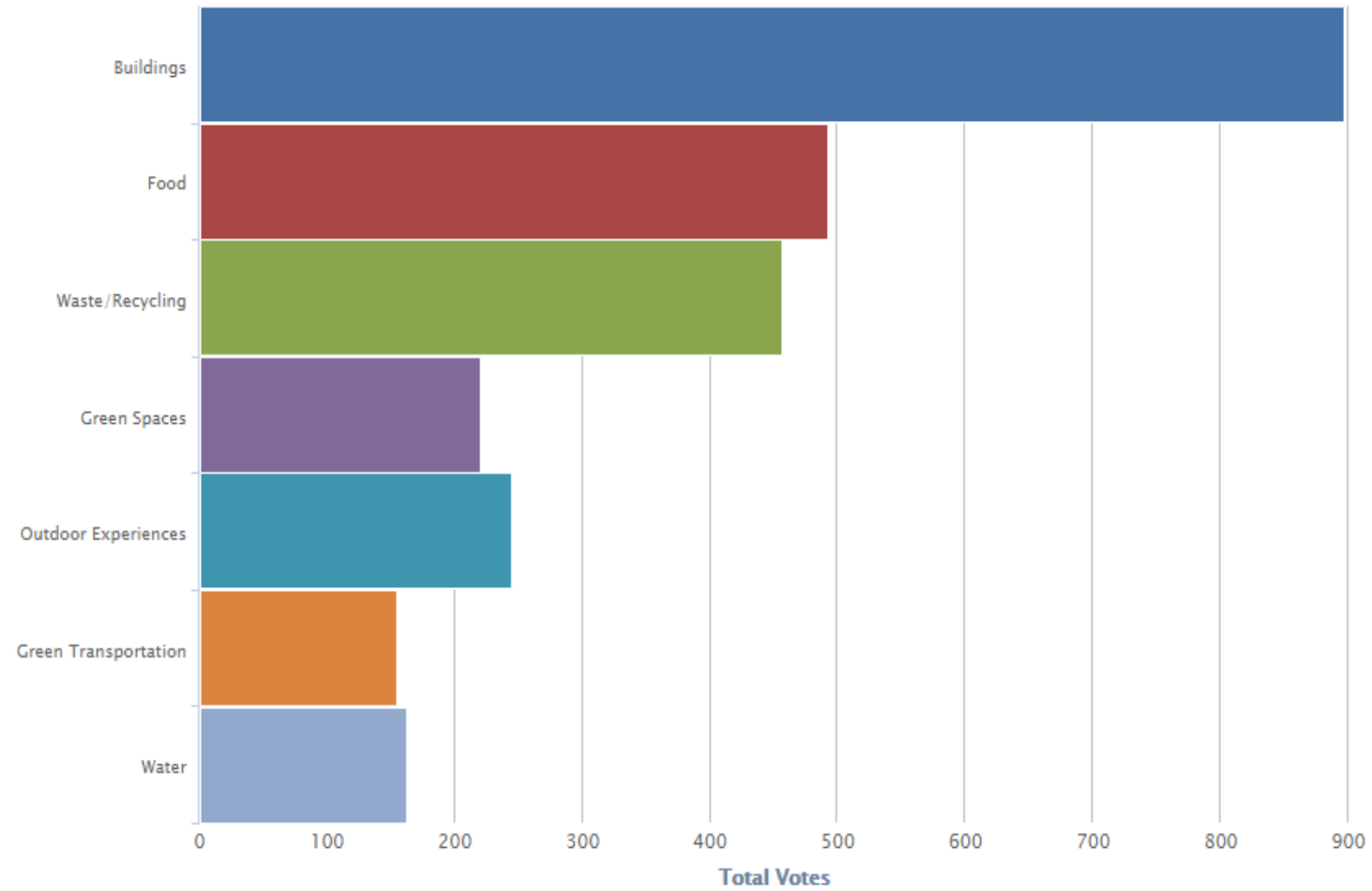


THE GARDEN: METHODS AND CURRENT STANDING



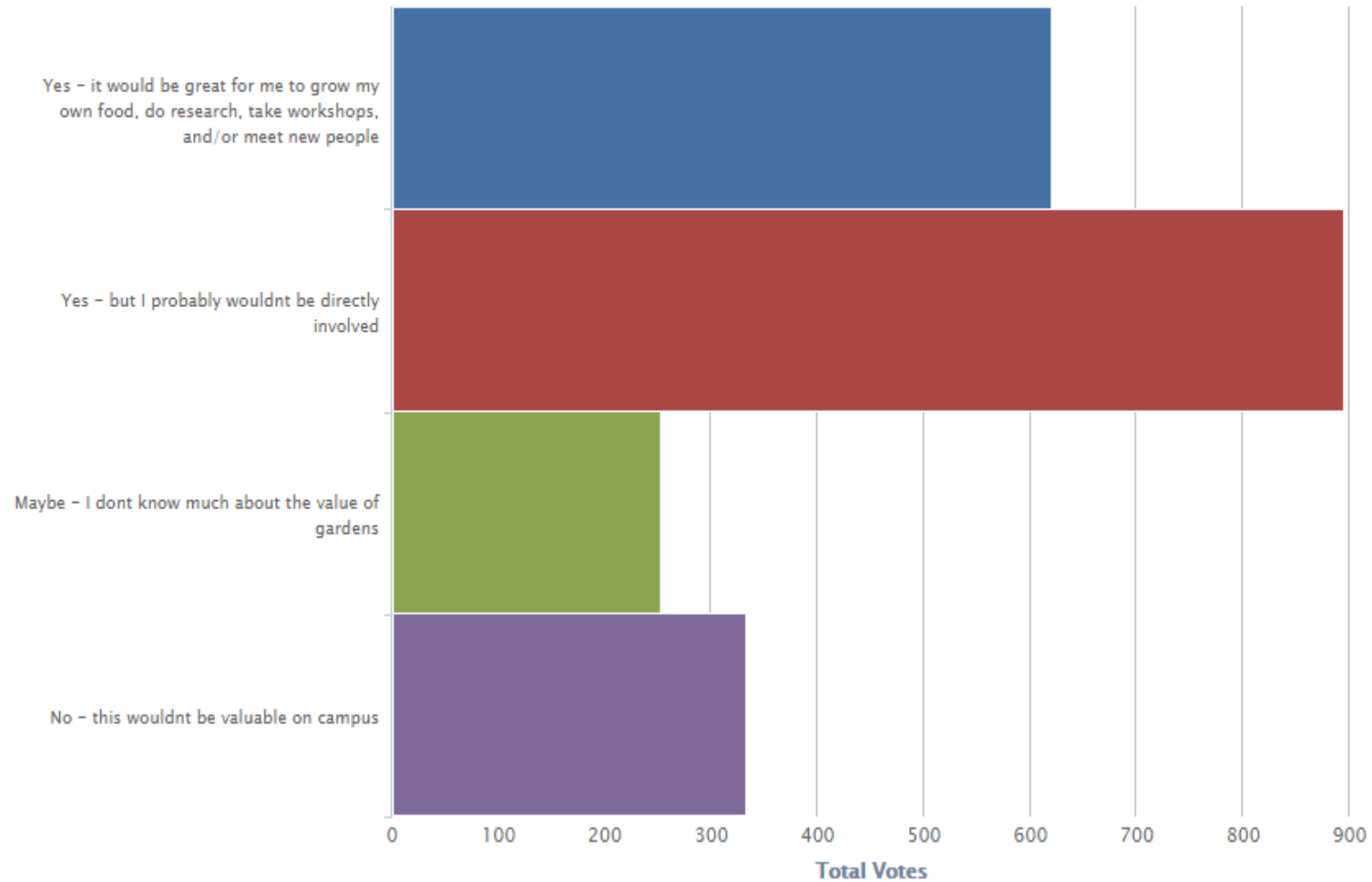
Where should UNB focus its Sustainability Efforts?
