Dear Mr. Long:

Tar Sands expansion is by far the most serious climate change issue to be dealt with in this country.

The proposed Energy East Pipeline and the marine terminal in Saint John will facilitate growth and expansion of the Tar Sands which could spur a 40 percent increase in Tar Sands production and generate more than a 30-million tonne increase in carbon pollution. Increased export of Tar Sands bitumen is not in the best interest of Canada or the ecological health of our planet.

The Government of Canada must say no and give a firm rejection to the Energy East Pipeline.
